- Each district has an allocation:  
**Oneonta CSD: \$1,276,085**
- No expiration on funds
- Requires a detailed Investment Plan

# Smart School Investment Plan

## BASIC STEPS

- ~~1. ITP — Instructional Technology Plan~~
- ~~2. Collaboration with stakeholders~~
- ~~3. Scope development~~
- ~~4. Letter of Intent to SED (project number established)~~
5. BOE preliminary (SSIP) approval
6. Web posting (30 Days)
7. Public hearing
8. Final plan approved by BOE
9. Final submission to SED



# Preliminary Plan Scope

- Data Room Improvements (School Connectivity): \$550,000  
Enclose all rooms and provide environmental conditioning, improve power redundancy, improve cable management, grounding and provide increased fiber optic backbone capacity.
- Wireless network upgrades (School Connectivity): \$120,000  
Improve wireless coverage to account for increased student capacity on the network (more devices).
- Security Camera Improvements (High Tech Security): \$135,000  
Upgrade of the existing security camera system to provide high quality camera resolution and lay the foundation for the system to grow.
- Secured Entrances at the Elementary Schools (High Tech Security): \$160,000  
Standardize the entrances at the Elementary Schools to provide a secured entrance into the main office with intercoms on the exterior and door controls that will dictate the policies enforced at the main entrances.
- Project Incidentals: \$311,085
