### Emergency School Closing Procedures

In the event it is necessary to close school early for the day due to inclement weather or other emergency reasons, the district's auto notification system will call each student's home or primary number, and parent cell phones. During that time, it is very likely that you will NOT be able to get through to the main office at school. Therefore, it is very important that you have a plan in place ahead of time for these situations and that your child knows what that plan is.

**A Message from Mr. Baskin:**

Please understand that the end of our school day can sometimes be very hectic. With that in mind, please consider the following dismissal guidelines:

- Changes to your child's normal dismissal plan should be sent to school in a note or be called in to the office *in the morning* rather than at the end of the day. We realize that there are times when circumstances may arise which may cause a change of plans late in the day and in that instance, we will make every effort to ensure your child is notified.
- Students who wish to go home with their parents after an assembly should wait to be dismissed at 3:05 pm rather than immediately following the assembly as this not only creates a bottleneck in the office at our busiest time of the day, but is also a fire hazard.
