### 1. Emergency Closings

Please read the information on the back regarding emergency school closings. Students should know ahead of time where they are to go in the event of an unscheduled closing.

### 2. Parking

Please do not park in front of the school between 8:20 am and 3:20 pm as this is a fire lane and bus loading area. In addition, please do not park near the stairs in the parking lot. This blocks the parking lot entrance and backs traffic up into the street.

### 3. Winter Weather Clothing

As the weather turns colder, students should come to school prepared to go outside for recess (boots, hats, gloves, snow pants). Students who do not have weather appropriate clothing will be asked to stay on the blacktop and will not be allowed on the back field at recess. In addition, please note that school policy states that students may not wear shorts to school from November 1st through April 1st.

### 4. Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up Reminders

- If you are dropping off or picking up students from the parking lot, please park in one of the designated parking spaces.
- If you are dropping off or picking up students from Valleyview Street in front of the school, please utilize only the side of the street that allows students to exit your vehicle directly on to the sidewalk in front of the school so students do not have to cross the street.
- Hudson Street (behind the school) can be used as an alternate pick-up/drop-off location. Students may enter school grounds from Hudson Street through the playground gate entrance.

### **EMERGENCY SNOW DAYS, EARLY CLOSINGS & SCHOOL DELAYS**

- In the event it is necessary to close school for the day due to inclement weather or other emergency reasons, the district's auto-notification system will call the home/primary number, cell number and work number for all parents/ guardians to alert them of the news. Please note that this information is also publicized on our local radio and television stations, as well as the Oneonta City School District website, and <u>The Daily Star</u> website.
- \* A one hour or two hour delay means that school will start one hour (9:25 am) or two hours (10:25 am) later than usual and that buses will be one or two hours late in their normal morning pick-ups depending on the length of the delay.
- \* If school is delayed ONE HOUR, the morning program will begin at 8:15 am. If school is delayed TWO HOURS, the morning program will begin at 9:15 am.
