

ndergarten & Grade 1 Classes are 'Meeting' Authors!

Each month Kindergarten & Grade 1 library classes are being introduced to a different Author of the Month, learning about their lives and reading their books. In September we met Ana Siqueira, a Hispanic-American children's author whose stories feature both English and Spanish. We learned several new Spanish words from the books we read together!
