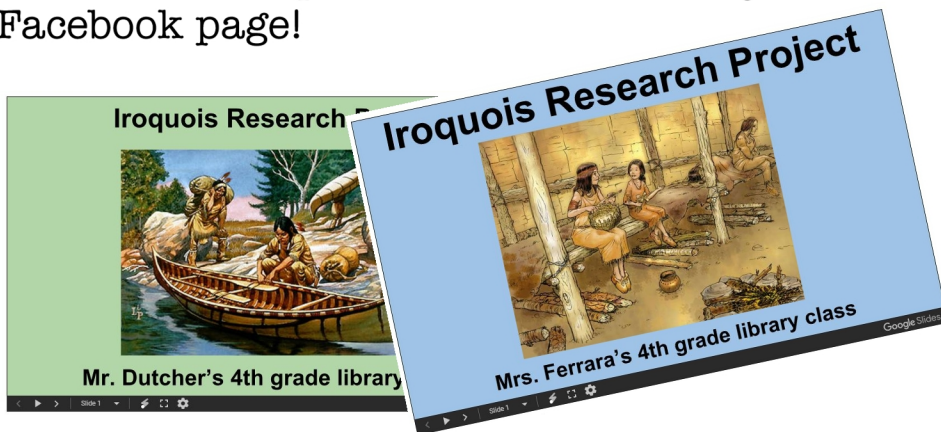

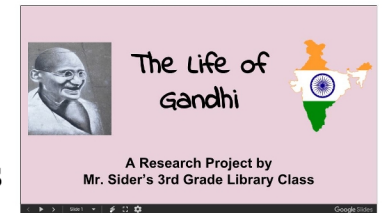
## 4TH GRADERS COMPLETE IROQUOIS RESEARCH PROJECTS!
