## Valleyview Students learning Keyboarding!

Various classes have begun using an instructional keyboarding program in the Computer Lab called Typing Pal. Typing Pal teaches students to develop proficiency with both typing accuracy and speed and it tracks each student's progress and requires proficiency in each activity before users can advance. Students in grades 1-5 who are working with Typing Pal in school can even use it at home, just have them show you how to follow the link from the Oneonta City School District webpage!
