



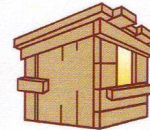

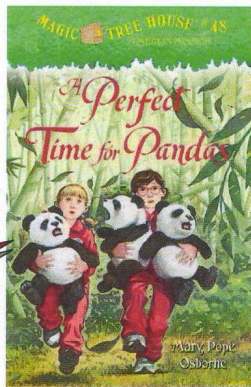
## Library Contest Asks:

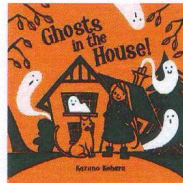

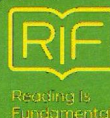
### Library to feature Halloween stories at Open House!
